#### Only days left for registrants with Preferential Registration or Reservation (PRR) to take action

Preferential Registration or Reservation (PRR) rights to .nz names direct at the second level are set to expire in a matter of days.

With the 1pm, 30 March 2015 deadline now just around the corner, DNCL reminds all registrants with PRR to consider their options before time runs out.

Registrants with PRR are able to register or reserve the shorter .nz version of their name before it becomes available for anyone to get.

However, if they haven't acted on their preferential rights by 1pm, 30 March 2015 the shorter version of the name will become available for anyone to get - on a first come, first served basis.

Registrants with PRR have three options. They can:

- Register the shorter .nz version of their name before anyone else, or
- Reserve it for free for a limited time, or
- Do nothing at all.

Registering is done through any .nz registrar or domain name provider. Reserving is a free service and is done at anyname.nz.

Whichever option chosen, it's important to know that there is no effect on any existing .nz domain name. All existing .nz domain names will continue as they always have - provided they're kept registered.

Please note that the following time limits apply for conflicted names that have been resolved:

- Names that were resolved before 29 January 2015 need to be registered by 1pm, 30 March 2015.
- Names resolved after 29 January 2015 need to be registered within two months of being resolved.





# Reminder - no timeframe for lodging a conflict preference

DNCL reminds registrants with a 'conflicted' name that there is no date or time limit for lodging a conflict preference. A conflicted name is one that has been registered in at least two different second levels.

Registrants with a conflicted name are able to go to anyname.nz with their UDAI and lodge a preference for who might get the shorter .nz version of the name. They can do this any time.

A reminder also that until a conflicted name is resolved the shorter .nz version will be unavailable for registration. Remember, conflicted names that have been resolved need to be registered within two months of being resolved.

# Registrations direct at the second level - by the numbers

As at 28 February, over 50,000 .nz names direct at the second level had been registered. There had been 10,858 reservations and 11,186 conflict preferences lodged. 2,665 conflicted names had been resolved.
