Interim Policies Consultation

InternetNZ has recently undertaken a review of the Group structure including NZRS and DNCL. This review has resulted in some changes which will be implemented in March 2018. One of the most significant impacts of the change regarding .nz will be that the Registry, NZRS, will be amalgamated into InternetNZ. There will be no change to the .nz operations, however the merger of NZRS and InternetNZ does mean some minor updates are required to the current .nz policies. These changes include removing reference to NZRS and referring instead to "the Registry", and updating contact details. The proposed amendments have been marked up on copies of the interim policies. These policies can be read and submissions made at dnc.org.nz/interim-policies. This consultation closes on Monday 26 March 2018.

Individual Registrant Privacy Option

The 28 March implementation date for the Individual Registrant Privacy Option (IRPO) as per policy is fast approaching. As at 26 February 2018, there are only 10 registrars (<u>https://dnc.org.nz/registrars</u>) who have begun offering IRPO. All Registrars are required by policy to offer IRPO by 28 March 2018. For any assistance with meeting this policy requirement, please send us an email. Registrants who wish to use IRPO must request the service for each individual domain name, and not a user account or entire portfolio. In order to qualify for IRPO, Registrants must not be using the domain name for significant trade (as defined by the Fair-Trading Act 1986), and are required to make a declaration to that effect when requesting the service. Port 43 Consultation outcome

At the DNCL Board meeting on 22 February 2018 the board considered the submissions from the Port 43 WHOIS Requirements Consultation. You can read more about that consultation and the submissions here <u>https://dnc.org.nz/port-43</u>. The board resolved that the Port 43 WHOIS will be reduced in the information that it returns. The Port 43 WHOIS will no longer show contact details of Registrant, Admin or Technical contacts or the date billed until information.

Next SRS Release 7.14

The next SRS release (7.14) is currently targeted for Sunday 11 March. In the 7.14 release there are a couple of changes that could have a minor impact to registrars, and these are detailed below.

WHOIS

There is a change to the Port 43 WHOIS response, the "registrant_contact_name" field has been changed to "registrant_name".

SRS Protocol and UDAI

For security reasons, and to avoid unnecessary storage of the UDAI, we are no longer returning UDAI in the GetMessages and ActionDetailsQry transaction response. UDAI are still returned in the DomainCreate and DomainUpdate responses. If the SRS server receives a request with the same RegistrarId and ActionId as a previous request, and identical request details, the server responds by returning the response that was sent to the original request. However, if the response contained a UDAI, then the UDAI is removed from the response and not sent.
