

Individual Registrant Privacy Option

From 28 November 2017 individual registrants who are not in significant trade will be able to choose to withhold their phone number and contact address from publicly appearing in a .nz WHOIS search (to be known as a .nz domain query).

The Individual Registrant Privacy Option means that while individual registrants are still accountable whilst they also have improved privacy controls if they choose.

Conflicted Names Process

The period for lodging preferences for the conflicted names process ended on the 18th of October with 6675 names being released on 27 October 2017 and a significant number of these have since been registered.
