Entries open for 2015 iSANZ Awards

Information security is an important part of the work of many registrars, and DNCL wanted to bring to the attention of .nz registrars that entries have now opened in the inaugural 2015 iSANZ Awards.

These Awards recognise excellence in New Zealand's InfoSec community, which DNCL supports through its involvement with the NZITF (New Zealand Internet Task Force).





Entries can be made at http://isanz.org.nz - including from any .nz registrar that has been doing interesting or innovative things with InfoSec, or has undertaken noteworthy security projects or initiatives.

SRS validation error

In early August, an SRS validation error allowed a .nz name to be registered that exceeded the maximum allowed number of characters at the third level of the name. Under .nz policy, the maximum length of each name element is 63 characters.

The domain was rejected by the DNS zone build validation. The domain was not included in NZRS' zone push to the name servers and was subsequently cancelled. A change to the SRS has been applied to resolve the validation issue.

Technical update from the Registry

Technical SRS Registrar Information Kit (RIK)

As part of NZRS' ongoing SRS architectural review, it is evaluating the Technical SRS Registrar Information Kit (RIK).

This kit currently comprises a Perl client which can make requests via the SRS protocol and a number of supporting library dependencies which are distributed as a package called 'cpan_libs'.

Based on NZRS' evaluation and analysis of the recent registrar satisfaction survey it is proposed that the following changes be made to the Technical RIK:

- The RIK clients will be provided as a Perl module on Github. This provides registrars with an easy and accessible location to source the RIK clients from when implementing the RIK into their own systems or when building the clients on unsupported platforms. This will also provide registrars with the ability to submit their own patches upstream.
- Currently NZRS builds and tests its cpan libs package against a number of different Linux distributions and architectures. NZRS' analysis shows most of these systems are not used by registrars, and as a result the 'cpan_libs' bundles will be discontinued. Instead NZRS will develop and test against a reference system (Ubuntu LTS on x64) and publish a complete .deb package for this platform including both clients and libraries.





 NZRS will distribute a VM image of the reference system with the latest client pre-installed. This will provide an easily accessible platform for registrars to issue adhoc SRS XML requests if necessary.

New SRS release coming

On 1 November 2015, NZRS will deploy a new major release of the SRS (SRS Release 7.0), which includes internal changes to its application, libraries, underlying operating system and deployment architecture.

This is a significant SRS release with a number of underlying changes. NZRS highly recommends that registrars test their systems against the SRS RPS environment, and the RPS environment is available to registrars for testing of Release 7.0.
