### **Providing UDAIs, Responsibilities and Good Customer Service**

The DNCL has recently been contacted by a number of domain name holders saying that either their Registrars, or Resellers, are making it difficult to obtain their UDAIs when they've asked for them.

Josh Cookson, who deals with Registrar Liaison and Compliance, says that customers are sometimes being sent in circles with either Registrars or Resellers redirecting customers to one another.

"It is very clear in our policies that UDAIs must be provided to Registrants on request. There should be no reason why domain name holders should not be given their UDAIs when they have been identified and specifically ask for them," he says.

Under the *Registering, Managing and Cancelling Domain Names* policy, the UDAI must be sent to Registrants on request and when the name is registered. If a Registrar has an automated system for generating a UDAI, they can either provide the UDAI or provide the Registrant with directions and a link for the Registrant to generate their own.

The DNCL would also like to remind all .nz Registars that their Resellers must abide by the DNCL's policies. Furthermore, Resellers also have to have their customers agree to their Registrar's .nz terms and conditions.

#### **Internet News**

Statistics New Zealand last week stated that more than half the population is now shopping online.

A survey measuring access to and use of computers, the Internet, and mobile phones showed the number of people making online purchases had increased by 11 per cent since 2009.

"The fact that more than 1.8 million people made online purchases in 2012 shows that our Internet use has evolved considerably from sending the occasional email," says Statistics New Zealand spokesperson Hamish Hill

That amounted to more than one-third of the working-age population and 400,000 more people than in 2009.
