



.nz NEWSLETTER – August 2005

:: DNC OFFICE ::

In July the number of active .nz domain names increased from 191,971 to 193,989, a net increase of 2,018. This is the lowest monthly growth since January 2004. There were 5,009 new domain names registered over the month but a large number of cancellations meant that the net growth was relatively low in comparison.

NZOC Meeting

The NZOC held a meeting on Friday 29th of July. A copy of the minutes from this meeting can be read at http://dnc.org.nz/content//minutes NZOC 29 July 05.pdf. Two points to note from the NZOC meeting were the discussions on the proposed change to the .iwi moderation policy and the .parliament.nz 2LD application.

Proposed change to .iwi Moderation Policy
Consultation on the proposed change with .iwi.nz registrants failed to produce sufficient responses. Only 45% of registrants responded to the correspondence from the DNC Office, short of the 75% sought by NZOC. At their meeting on 29 July, NZOC formally declined the application to amend the .iwi.nz moderation policy and the moderator has been informed of that decision.

• .parliament.nz Application

Additional documents pertaining to the application for the new 2ld .parliament.nz arrived the night before the NZOC meeting. Therefore the NZOC members did not have time to review this new material before they met. The NZOC agreed to review the papers and that discussion on the documents and the application would take place via email over the next few weeks.
