In July, the number of active .nz domain names increased from 286,539 to 291,817, a net increase of 5,278.

Registering, Managing and Cancelling (RMC) Policy Review – Third Consultation

InternetNZ, through the Domain Name Commission (DNC), is currently reviewing the Registering, Managing and Cancelling Domain Names policy. An initial call for comments on the policy review resulted in four submissions being received. These can be seen at http://dnc.org.nz/rmc-review. A second call for comments on some of the proposals raised as a result of the initial consultation was undertaken. Nine submissions were received as a result of that and these, together with the consultation paper, can be seen at http://dnc.org.nz/rmc-2ndconsult.

Proposed changes to the policy relating to operational matters and general updating were accepted by submissions received, by the Registrar Advisory Group and by the .nz Oversight Committee (NZOC) and so have been processed. An amended policy containing these changes has been published.

In respect of the proposals that would involve changes to the registration policy principles, NZOC acknowledged that these represented a radical departure from the current 'first come, first served', open registration approach that has been in place in .nz since 1987. Careful consideration of the issues is required. NZOC considers it important that the operational implications are identified and that all parties are given a chance to comment not only on the policy principles but also on the potential time, cost and liability implications of any change to the current registration process.

Changes to the SRS that have been implemented over the past few months have resulted in a total of 8 seconds of outages during July, this equates to 100percent availability (figures are rounded to 2 decimal places). Thanks to Dave Baker and the team in leading this project to strengthen the stability of the system by the implementation of the recent changes that have been made to the Front End replication layer.

Domain Name Fee change

On 1 July, the wholesale domain name fee was dropped from \$1.75 to \$1.50 ex GST per month; this reflects the second drop in the Domain name fee since 2002.

Availability

As noted there was a total of 8 seconds outage to the SRS this month. During July the SRS was available for 100% of the month (figures are rounded to 2 decimal places). This is the second time that availability has reached 100% (the first being in January 2004).
