Six months of DNSSEC in New Zealand

Domain Name System Security Extensions (DNSSEC) implementation conforms to best practice methods and helps with online security. The .nz landscape is well placed to help Registrars implement these security services and we are more than happy to answer any questions regarding this.

DNSSEC have now been enabled in New Zealand for six months and, so far, two .nz Registrars are signed up offer this higher level of service.

"DNSSEC is simple, inexpensive and uses proven solutions to prevent many domain name related scams. If people don't see the value already, I think they soon will," DNC Manager Security Policy Barry Brailey says.

"As people become more knowledgable about Internet scams and computer security – which are increasingly in the public eye and media reports – I imagine consumers will probably request these types of services. Eventually, I believe everyone will probably introduce DNSSEC. As such, it makes sense for Registrars to investigate the process sooner, rather than later."

DNC Staff in Singapore

ONECheck tool gains momentrum

The Government's new ONECheck tool is proving a success with over 23,000 ONECheck searches done in its first two months of operation. The one-stop search tool combines a company name, domain name, and trade mark search all in one place.

After doing the search, the user is then given information about how to register all that information. All Registrars listed on the site are drawn from the randomized list on the DNC's website at http://dnc.org.nz//story/authorised-registrars.
