Watershed moment as registrations direct at second level go live

The .nz domain name space experienced a watershed moment at the end of September - with people able to get .nz names directly at the second level, as well as under all other .nz registration options.

Shortly after launch there was a small period of degraded SRS performance, which the Registry attributes to a combination of load, events and transactions hitting the database. The issue was quickly resolved and by day's end 14,902 names direct at the second level had been registered; 1,359 names had been reserved and 282 'conflicted' names resolved.

Most people who already hold a .nz domain name are able to get the shorter version of their name before anyone else and take advantage of a six month period of time called the Preferential Registration Eligibility (PRE) period – to register or reserve the shorter version. The PRE period ends at 1pm, 30 March 2015.

Others may find their .nz domain name is 'conflicted'. A conflicted name is one that's been registered in at least two different second levels. For example, one person may hold the .co.nz version while another person may hold the .net.nz or .org.nz version. People whose names are conflicted need to agree among themselves who might get the shorter version of the name and can lodge a conflict preference at anyname.nz.

It's important that anybody who already holds a .nz domain name checks to see if they're conflicted or eligible for preferential registration or reservation rights. To learn more about the different eligibility types go to anyname.nz or speak with any .nz registrar or domain name provider.

30-day UDAI expiry; reminder for registrars

Registrars are reminded that UDAIs (Unique Domain Authorisation ID) now expire after 30 days and that each time a customer asks for their UDAI you need to generate them a new one.

Following the launch of registrations direct at the second level you may be noticing a higher than usual number of UDAI requests coming in from some of your customers. This is because eligible registrants need their UDAI to register a .nz name direct at the second level – UDAIs are also needed to reserve a name and lodge a conflict preference at anyname.nz.





Statistics
