.nz Policy Reviews - ZTP and RMC

As part of the ongoing review of .nz policies, two policies are now being reviewed.

The policies being reviewed are:

Zone Transfer Policy

This policy relates to the release of the .nz zone file to organisations outside the registry company.

Registering, Managing and Cancelling Domain Names Policy

This policy sets out the general rules regarding the .nz domain name space including registration requirements, the information required to be on the .nz register and the general business processes that .nz operates. Currently the policy defines such things as:

- Five day registration and renewal grace periods
- A maximum registration term of 120 months
- 90 day pending release period
- The requirement for registrars to send information to the registrant upon registration, including the UDAI (Unique Domain Authentication ID)
- Restrictions on when a domain name can be cancelled
- Locking of .nz domain names

No operational issues have been identified with the current policies. They are being reviewed as part of the regular, ongoing review of .nz policies.

DNSSEC

We are very close to publishing dates for deployment of DNSSEC.

Production readiness testing of DNSSEC is almost complete. We are also pleased with the results of community consultation to date, and have worked with the feedback received. Finally, we ran an official rehearsal for the Key Generation procedure, which was audited by Lateral Security. We are now awaiting the report from Lateral Security, before publishing dates for deployment.

The most recent version of the DNSSEC Practice Statement for .nz, is <u>Version 1.2</u>. No further issues have been raised by the community.

SRS CA Certificate

The SRS CA certificate in the current RIK is due to expire on 30/09/2011. it has been extended by 2 years and is available in the new SRS RIK 5.15.

If you are using the current SRS CA certificate to validate the SRS SSL certificate then you must upgrade to the new SRS CA certificate provided in the SRS RIK 5.15.

If you are using the RIK Clients to communicate with the SRS then you must upgrade to the new RIK or replace the SRS CA certificate with the SRS CA certificate provided in the SRS RIK 5.15.

EPP

We have deployed a functioning version of the SRS EPP interface to the SRS production system.
